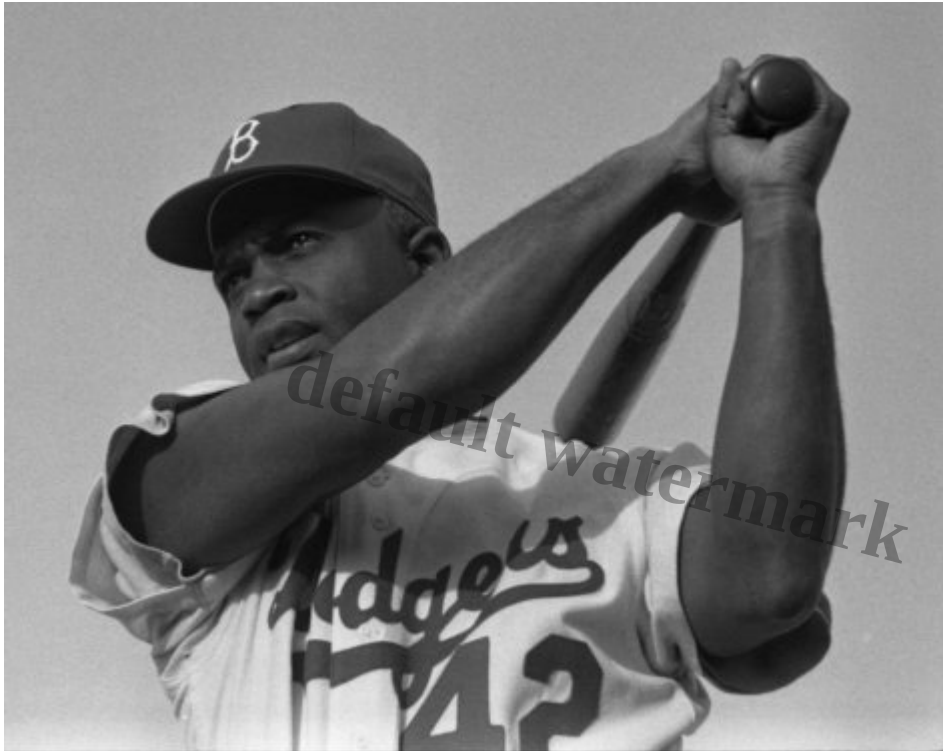


Buying Your First Baseball Bat
