

3 Things to Consider When it Comes to Your Roof

Description

The roof is part of the main structure of a property and therefore an important consideration when it comes to maintaining a home or business premises. When your Roof was Installed

When you buy a house or have lived at a property for a while it is important to consider how long your roof has been fitted. Also, whether it has been repaired recently. If the roof has been untouched for a while then it should be inspected for possible damage that has resulted from the elements or certain species of animal or bird known to cause it. If the roof has been repaired, for how long has the work been guaranteed? This is an indication as to how long the work carried out might last for.

Materials

It is important to consider how fire-resistant your roof is. There are three fire ratings: Class A, for roofs that are effective against the most severe exposure to fire; Class B, that have moderate protection; and Class C which is only lightly fire-resistant.

To best protect your roof from fire, you should consider the common Class A roofing materials that exist. These include asphalt, concrete, fibre glass, composition shingles, and flat/barrel-shaped tiles. Roofs that have a *“by assembly”* Class A rating in terms of fire mean that any extra materials that have been used must be between the roof covering and the sheathing for the Class A rating to still exist.

What is Underneath

If you are a business and your stock lies below a roof, then you will want to make sure that there are no leaks. This can prove expensive and when balanced against timely roof repairs makes the prospect of them extremely cost-effective. A continually leaking roof can cause more damage to the roof and result in a more costly repair bill than would otherwise have been necessary.
