Description

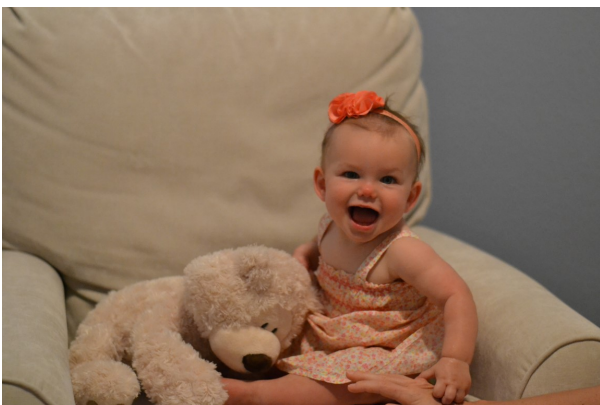
Every month we have been taking a picture of Avery in the same chair with the same bear; nothing different.
