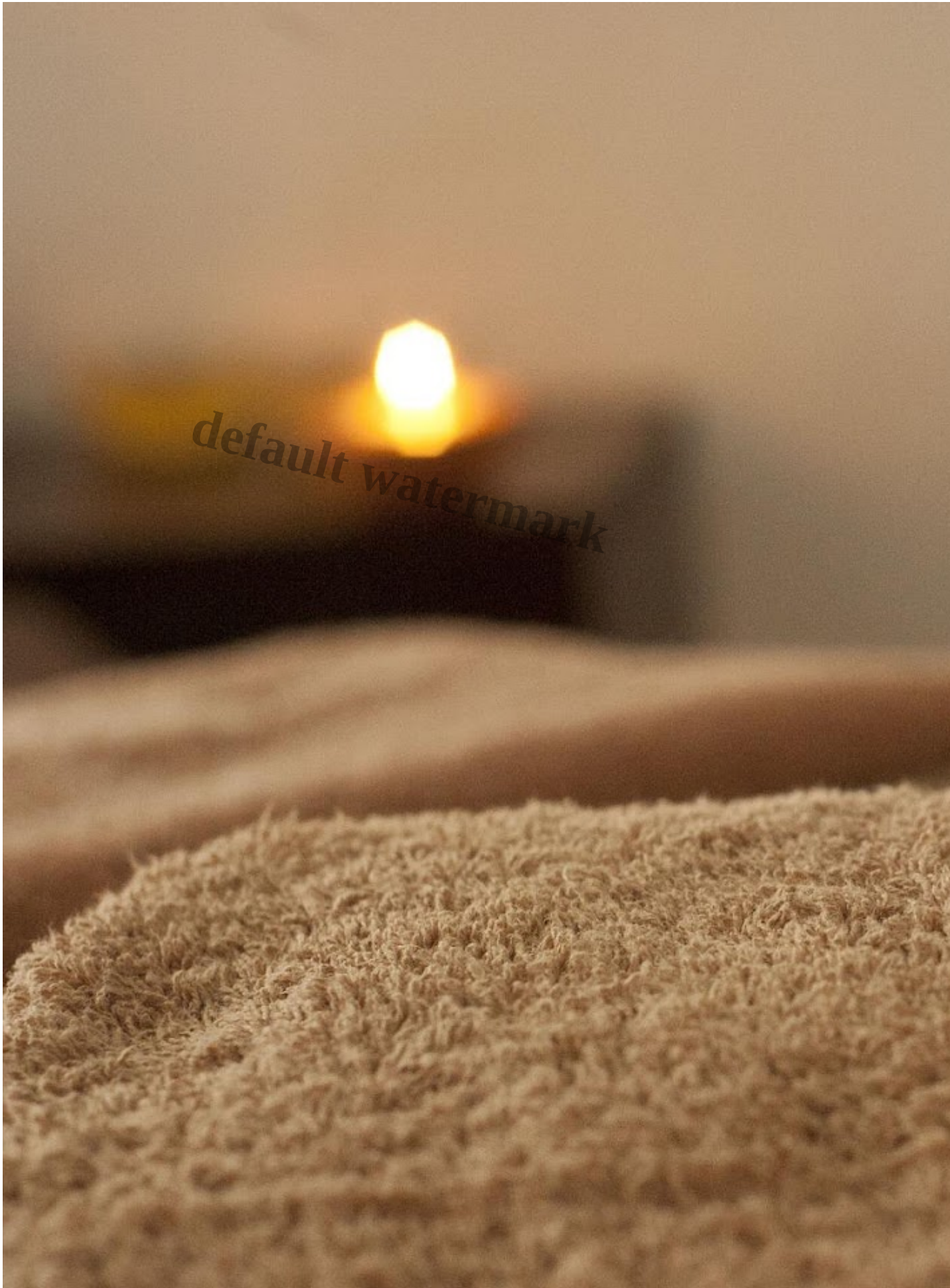


3 Stress-Free Ways To Look After Your Health
