

Best Way To Install Peel And Stick Wallpaper For a Whole Room Makeover

Description

Before we get to the method, it is noteworthy that a peel and stick wallpaper best adheres to smooth surfaces.

To make sure that you buy the correct [wallpaper peel and stick](#) type, consult with your manufacturer or retailer first.

Another noteworthy point is to buy wallpapers in excess of how many you need. Doing so would allow you to experiment with your designs and placements.

Being said that, hereâ€™s the best way you can install peel and stick wallpaper for a whole room makeover.

Gather The Supplies

Before you begin installing your ombre peel and stick wallpaper or any other wallpaper for that matter, you would need some supplies. For instance, youâ€™d need a sponge or a soft cloth to wipe off all the extras from the corners. Youâ€™d also need a mild cleaner to clean the walls before installing. Other supplies that youâ€™d need include a measuring tape, straight-edge, a pencil, a smoothing tool, and a utility knife.

Prepare Walls

Now that youâ€™ve gathered all the necessary supplies, itâ€™s time to prepare the walls for wallpapers. Clean the walls using a damp soft cloth or sponge and a mild non-abrasive cleaner. The next 24 hours would be very crucial for your wallpaper peel and stick project. Let the walls dry out completely and ensure that dust or dirt does not settle over again.

Make A Guide For First Piece

The next thing you ought to be doing is measuring your wallpapers. If youâ€™re choosing an [ombre peel and stick wallpaper](#), make sure you consider the color gaps too. Weâ€™ll come to it in the next section. For now, the vital thing to remember is that you guide the walls according to the design you wish to create. You might need to trim off extra wallpaper from one edge to fit it on the wall properly in some cases. And for this, guides prove to be the best tool.

Match And Repeat Patterns

The next step is placing your first wallpaper. Make sure that you double-check all the measurements and the placement for your ombre peel and stick wallpaper. It would be better to peel only about 12 inches of the wallpaper peel and stick a protective covering. Place the first on the guide and slowly peel off the rest of the cover from the back. While you do so, make sure you also use the smoothing tool. Once the first wallpaper is placed, all you need to do is match the first one and repeat the patterns.

Check For Bubbles

While using the smoothing tool would already ensure that not too many bubbles are created, there might still be some. To remove these bubbles, you can use the edge of your trimming knife or a pin. Press down the pointy edge onto the bubble to remove any trapped air. Also, youâ€™d need to press it gently after removing the bubbles to make sure it does not create any holes or tear off later.

And youâ€™re done! Your wallpaper peel and stick design is good to go.

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
