Made in the USA from 100% recycled plastic with no BPA, phthalates, or PVC, I feel confident in giving my daughter a toy thatâ€™s safe and Earth friendly. Even the packaging is made with recycled

materials using soy ink for printing.

But both the Rescue Boat and Helicopter use her trampoline as a giant landing pad shared by her other Green Toys friends.
