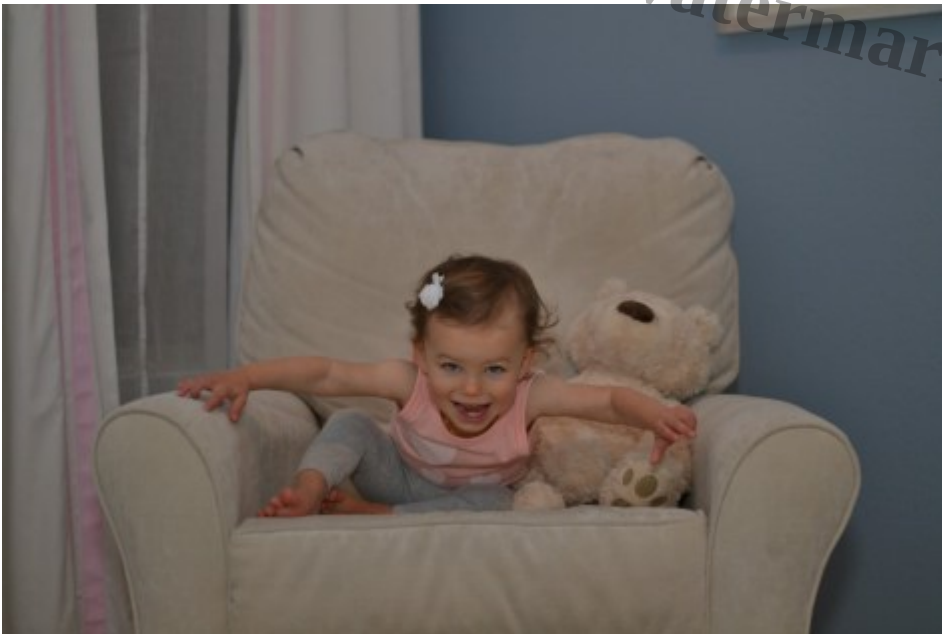

Which only made Avery increasingly interested in the little white thing clipped to her hair. Maybe it would be something good to eat?



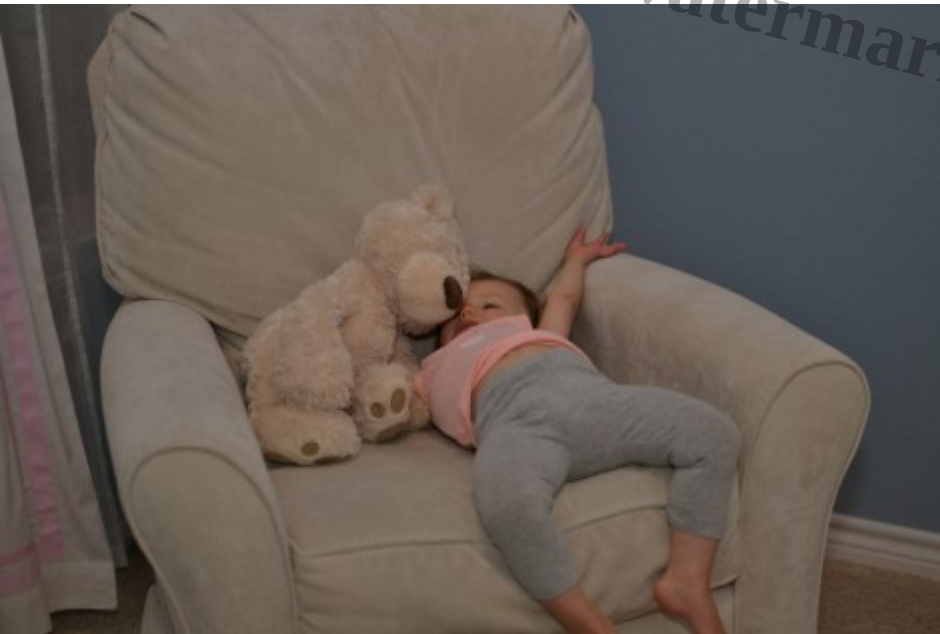
Nope, maybe handing it to Daddy would be better.
