Description

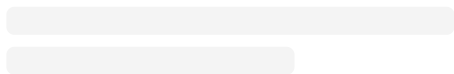
Remember my [Foodie Facts post on Friday](#)? I mentioned how Going Mom and I went on a much needed date night while G-Ma watched Avery.

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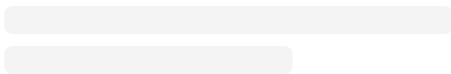
