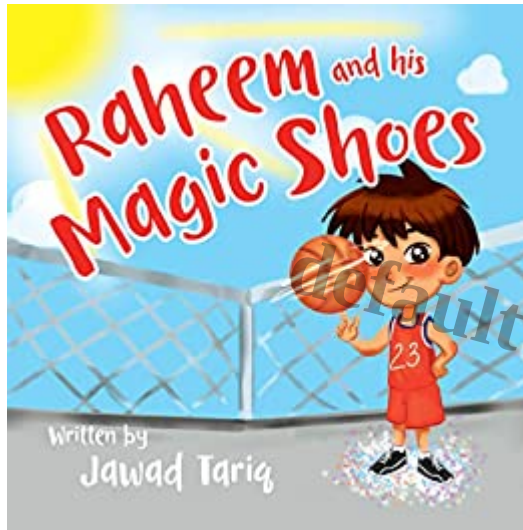


Raheem™s Adventures: Fun and Educational Children™s Books

The following 3 books by the author, Jawad, have been written with a fun and educational spirit. Jawad was kind enough to share details on each of his books below, please read on to learn more about them.



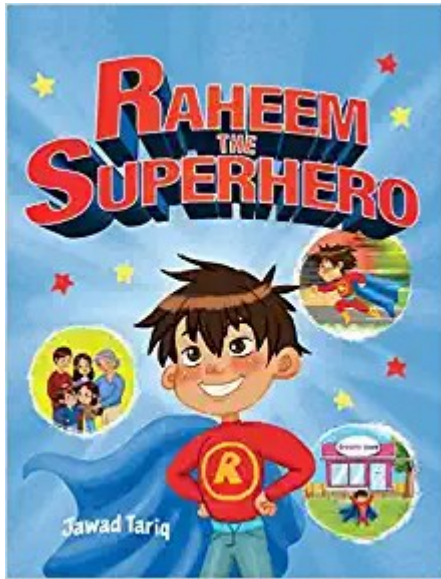
Raheem and his Magic Shoes:

Raheem the Superhero:

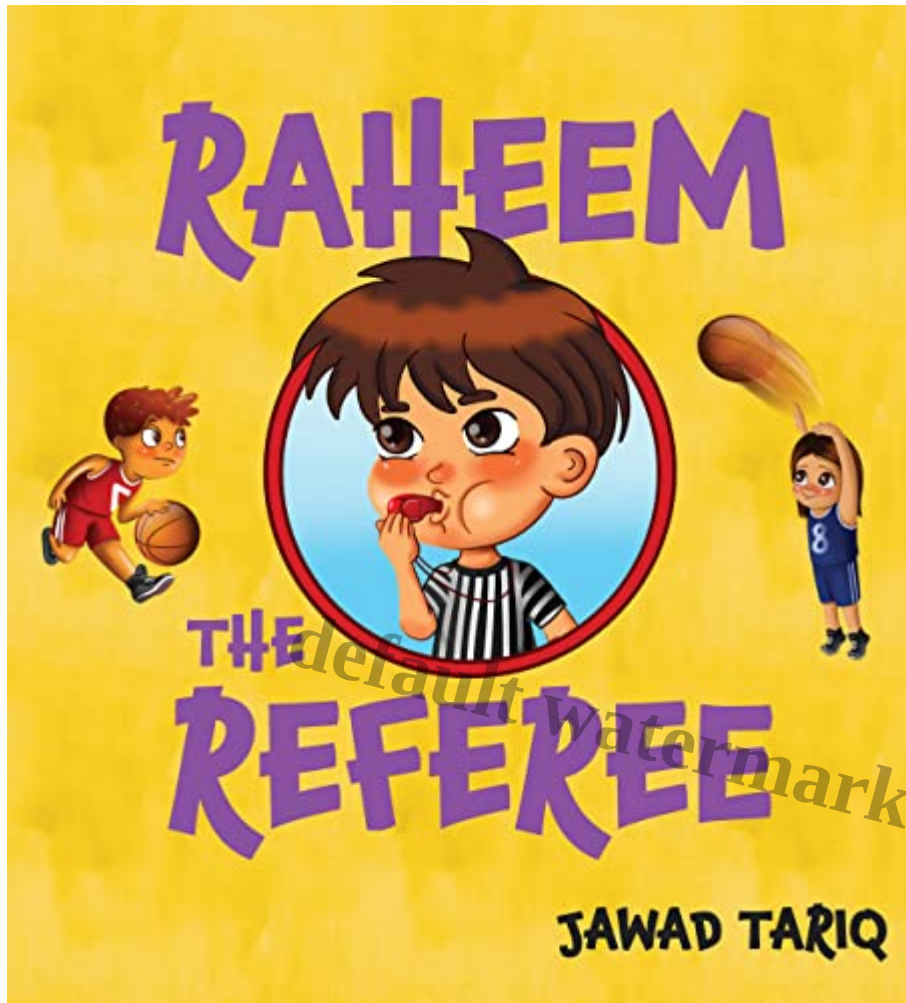
This fun read was inspired by my little nephew who loves superheroes and his willingness to help others in need.
