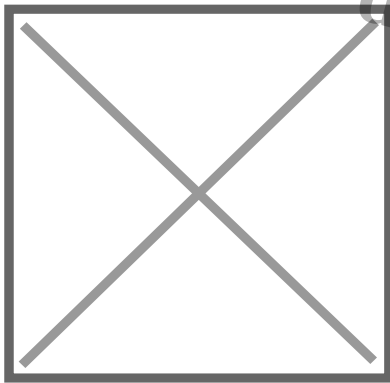


## Going Reviews: Down To Earth Toys – Eco-Friendly Toys for Kids of All Ages
