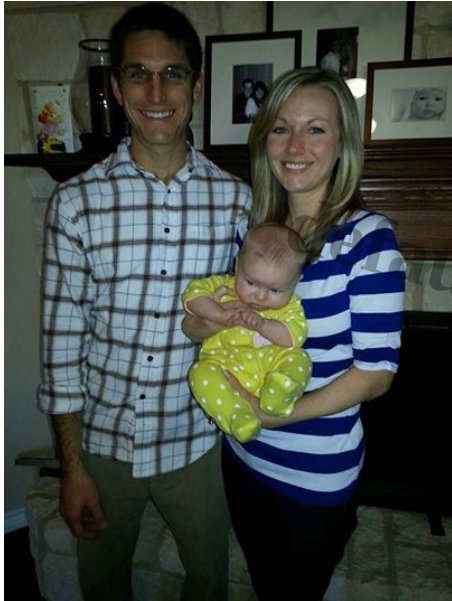


Our First Night Without Avery “ Part 2

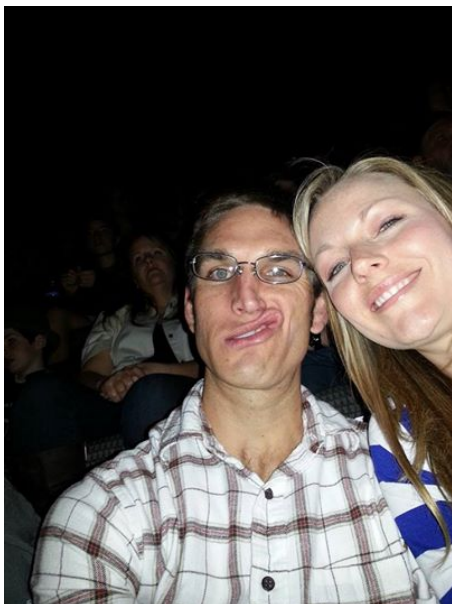
Still classy b/c we used
